Town of Clifton Forge Tax Tickets Mailed

The Town of Clifton Forge first half real estate and personal property tax bills have been mailed out. The deadline for payment is December 5th.

Taxpayers should check their tax bills to be sure they have received a statement for each piece of real estate and every vehicle they own. Town residents should have received personal property and real estate tickets from Alleghany County and Clifton Forge. If you do not have all of your Town tickets, please call the Finance Department at 863-2505.

Real Estate tickets that have been requested in writing by mortgage companies have been sent directly to them. You need to contact your mortgage company if you receive a tax ticket that you believe they should be paying.

All tax tickets have been mailed to the most current addresses on file. Failure to receive a tax ticket does not relieve the taxpayer of penalty or interest according to the Virginia State Code. The law also requires payment on delinquent accounts before current accounts can be paid.

If taxpayers have questions concerning assessments of personal property or real estate, they should contact the Alleghany County Commissioner of Revenue's office at 863-6640. Real estate and personal property is assessed by the County.

Town taxes may be paid at Town Hall, Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding legal holidays. Payments may also be placed in the black payment box that is located directly in front of Town Hall. Payments can be mailed to P. O. Box 75, Clifton Forge Virginia 24422. Mail must be postmarked on or before December 5th in order to avoid penalty.
