

What is the function of the Department of Public Works?

The Department of Public Works field staff carries out the following duties:

- A. Streets & Roads:
 - 25 miles of roads - including snow plowing, snow removal, salting, sanding, grading, pothole patching, and sweeping
 - Road culverts - to include repairing and replacing
 - Roadside drainage - to include shoulders and ditch lines
 - Sidewalks
 - small bridges and large drainage structures
 - Street and traffic signs
 - Vehicle fleet; preventative maintenance, repair, diagnostics and fabrication
 - Including Police vehicles

- B. Cemetery:
 - Provide year-round burials for 3 municipal cemeteries
 - Mowing via contract services

- C. Bulk and Brush pick-up:
 - Provide service to residents
 - Two days per week one for bush, one for bulk

- D. Water Distribution:
 - Maintain – to include cleaning, inspecting, repairing/replacing
 1. 35 miles of water distribution mains
 2. 200 hydrants - exercising gates
 3. 1700+ water meters – to also include collecting monthly readings

- E. Sanitary and Storm water Sewer:
 - repairing/replacing
 1. Catch basins
 2. 25 miles of sewer lines
 3. 705 manholes
 4. 3 sewer pump stations

- F. Water and Wastewater Treatment
 - The Town operates the Water Treatment Plant through a separate department
 - The maintenance of the wastewater pump stations is accomplished by a contract through Alleghany County
 - The Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant is owned and operated by Alleghany County

Household trash is collected by Alleghany County Public Works. Please contact Alleghany Public Works at 540-863-6650.

The Department of Public Works business office staff includes (1) Director of Public Works; (1) Administration/Office Manager who also provides administrative support. (1) Chief Mechanic; (1) Public Works Superintendent, (1) Water/Wastewater Superintendent, (1) Supervisor, (3) Water or Sewer Technician, (5) Skilled Laborers
